

How Do I Recycle?

Aluminum and Tin

Examples of what is accepted:

- Fruit & vegetable cans
- Beverage cans
- Metal lids from glass jars and bottles.
- Pet food tins
- Coffee cans



To avoid injury to your collector, please place lids from cans inside the can, and pinch the top of the can to trap the lid inside. All items must be rinsed and lids and labels removed.


#1, #2, #5, and #7 Plastic

Examples of what is accepted:

- Pop bottles
- Juice bottles
- Shampoo bottles
- Detergent bottles
- Milk jugs

All items must be rinsed and lids and labels removed.

How do I know if my plastic bottle is recyclable?

There is a number stamped on the bottle usually on the bottom. The number is surrounded by the recycling symbol  and the numbers range from 1-8. Only #1, #2, #5, and #7 are accepted.



Paper and Newspaper

Examples of what is accepted:

- Brown paper sacks
- Newspaper
- White office paper
- Computer paper
- Wrapping paper

Please put all of these items in plastic (please do not use black) bag or tie together with a string to keep from blowing.



Cardboard

Examples of what is accepted:

- Corrugated cardboard
- Toy boxes
- Waxed food cartons
- Pop and beer containers
- Detergent boxes



Cardboard boxes must be flattened and tied with string in bundles. Bundles must be no larger than 24"x30"x12". All Styrofoam and plastic liners, inserts, wrappings and staples must be removed from cardboard boxes.

Items That We Do Not Accept

Glass

Per the owner of Gill Hauling, Inc. glass **will not** be accepted.

Metal:

- Aluminum foil
- Pie plates
- Batteries
- Coat hangers
- License plates
- Paint cans
- Aerosol cans
- Cooking pots and pans.

Paper:

(Per owner of Gill Hauling, Inc.)

- Books
- Magazines
- Shredded paper
- Envelopes with cellophane windows
- Junk mail laminated paper

Miscellaneous:

- Styrofoam
- Bubble wrap
- Kleenex
- Diapers
- Feminine products
- Wicker wood
- Food items
- Oil jugs
- Any unmarked plastics
- Containers used for chewing tobacco.

Hazardous Materials:

No hazardous materials of any kind.

Gill Hauling, Inc. offers this service free of charge and reserves the right to refuse any recyclables we see fit. Refused recyclables will be disposed of in the garbage truck. Due to the recycling truck unable to get around in bad weather, recycling will probably not be picked up on those days. If you would like an extra recycle bin please call **402-632-9273**. There is no charge for extra recycling bins.

- Please bag or tie your recyclables. If you choose to bag, please use white or clear Hy-Vee type bags.
- Do not use black bags
- Wash the beer and pop cans out, even one dirty item ruins the whole bin.

Please have your recyclables and trash out by 5:00 a.m.

This is only curb side service, not alley, except on Main Street and Highway 35 in Wayne.
